

DNACA's 35th Annual Juried Multimedia Exhibition

Thursday August 20, 2026 - Thursday October 22, 2026 ~ Del Norte County Courthouse

Eligibility: All Northern California and Southern Oregon artists.

*participating as an Artist in this exhibition qualifies you to be selected for a solo exhibition opportunity at one of DNACA's Art in Public Places locations, as long as DNACA hasn't given you a show in the last 2 years.

Entry Rules:

- 1 Only **wall-hangable artwork** accepted; size **limit to 24 inches x 30 inches**, including frame.
2. Work must be completed in the last 2 years.
3. Artist may enter 2 pieces. *Note : no guarantee both or any will get into show.
4. No group / collaboration works may enter.
5. **Must be original art** (no reproductions or giclées). Original prints (e.g. linocut) are okay.
6. No work can be accepted that has been previously shown in one of DNACA's Juried Multimedia Exhibitions.
7. Submitted items must be dry, properly framed (if applicable). No claw hangers. Use **strong, braided metal picture hanging wire secured tightly between two eye screws, screwed into the frame.**
8. No art will be released before the breakdown of the exhibit before 3 p.m. on October 22, 2026.

Labeling:

Attach a label **on the back of each piece with the artist's name, address, phone number, artwork title, and medium.** (Signature on front will be covered during judging.)

Entry Fees:

1. \$10 per piece is required at the time of submission (cash or checks only). *non-refundable

Delivery/Pick up of the Artwork:

2. Artwork, along with your entry forms and fees, should be delivered between 1 and 3 p.m. on **Thurs. August 20th, 2026** to the **Del Norte County Courthouse, 450 H St in Crescent City.** If you can't make it that day, no problem. Call DNACA office **in advance** to make arrangements at 707-464-1336.
3. Friends of artist may drop off art, forms, and fees if artist is not able to do so.
4. Artwork that has not been selected will be notified the following workday via phone or email. Pick-up of artwork will be at DNACA office, 224 F St., Crescent City.

Classifications/Jurors/Awards:

1. All media will be judged against each other.
2. The show will be judged by two professional artists.
3. Modest cash awards (commensurate with the number of entries) will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. Up to five (5) honorable mentions may also be given, at the discretion of the judges.

Reception and Awards will be on Oct 22 at 3pm in the lobby of the courthouse. Refreshments will be provided by DNACA.

Commissions: 25% Commission is kept by DNACA. Sold works must be kept on display until show ends, unless otherwise approved.

DNACA Juried Exhibition Agreement

Insurance: For individual artworks with a fair market value or insured value of \$500 or less, DNACA will make reasonable efforts to provide compensation to the Artist in the event of covered damage or loss. This is offered as a goodwill gesture and is subject to available budget, proper documentation of value, and confirmation of the loss.

Hold Harmless: Artist holds DNACA not at fault from any damage to or loss of the Artist's artwork due to the Artist's negligence.

Warranties: Artist confirms this is original Artwork done by them. That there is no infringement of copyright.

Sales: 25% commission is kept by DNACA. Sold works must remain on display until show ends (unless approved otherwise). Payment within 30 days of closing.

General: Governed by California law.

By signing below, I understand that all my works, including sold items, must remain displayed at the Courthouse until the show concludes on October 22, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. (except by express permission—in advance—from DNACA).
