Executive Director Report for December 2024

Legislative/Policy Work

- 1. ODMAP application is extended to December 13th.
 - 1. The small print: ODMAP 2024 will be paid out as follows: 75% if the \$1.68/cwt initially and the other 25% if there is money left over out of the \$58 million still allocated.
 - 2. **EVERY farmer** needs to re-register for the 2024 payment using 2023 milk production.
 - 3. Reach out to your local FSA office NOW!!!
 - 4. Producers who had to project production should now be getting approved.
- 2. Organic Dairy Assistance, Investment, and Reporting Yields Act of 2023 (O DAIRY Act of 2023) Senate Bill 3097
- 3. "The Organic Dairy Data Collection Act" House Bill 6937
- 4. Elections/ Appointments:
 - 1. Farm Bill update
 - i. Most of the key programs have funding through the end of the calendar year. Then it will revert to "permanent law". Both the House and the Senate approved the stopgap spending bills at the end of September to avoid a partial government shutdown. The continuing resolution will keep the federal government running through December 20th.
 - ii. House Republicans rejected the Farm Bill language put forth by Senate Democrats in November.
 - 2. Nominating Brooke Rollins for Secretary of Ag
 - i. focuses heavily on foreign farm ownership
 - ii. served as White House domestic policy chief during 1st Trump administration
 - 3. Nominating Robert F. Kennedy to be head of Department of Health & Human Services
 - 4. Republicans "trifecta" Presidency, House and Seante
