University of Vermont Extension is asking dairy producers to participate in a national survey to identify key research priorities, and resources that are integral in optimizing forage production on organic dairy farms through a changing climate. Forage production and quality are the backbone of organic dairy farms and there is enormous pressure to produce both high yield and high quality feed that will sustain the herd through the year without sacrificing milk production, milk quality, or animal health.



The information generated from this project will be valuable to all organic livestock farmers across the country and will also provide valuable insight to policy makers, governmental agencies, and academic institutions to understand the importance and value of forages and the need for continued support for research and extension efforts.

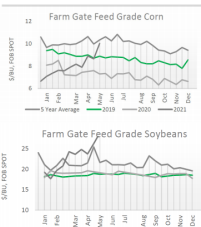

ORGANIC DAIRY FLUID OVERVIEW

Dutch Organic Milk Price: In the Netherlands, a large processor of organic milk announced that the price for organic milk, announced from May 2021, is €8.75 (€10.10/kg, currently \$79.48 USD). The organic milk producer supplies an average of 500,000 kilograms of milk, containing a fat content of 4.2 percent, protein content of 3.37 percent and a lactose content of 4.53 percent, on an annual basis.

Organic Milk Retail Prices for Selected U.S. Cities: The May 2021 in-store surveys of selected supermarkets in thirty U.S. cities reveal that the retail prices of organic whole milk, in half-gallon containers, range from \$3.14 in Houston, TX, to \$5.84 in Pittsburgh, PA. The U.S. single average price, \$4.11, is up two points from April 2021. Twenty-five of the selected cities' organic whole milk, in half-gallon containers, showed prices did not change compared to April 2021 retail prices. The largest price increase, over the previous month, for organic whole milk, in half-gallon containers occurred in New York, NY, up 27 cents.

Operators of a U.S. creamery that suffered major damages from a fire earlier this spring continue to work through challenges. The dairy operation previously took in 300,000 pounds of milk a day from nearby farms. The operators are working with regional processors. Reports indicate that most of the organic milk is being processed at other plants via conventional handling methods, as some operations do not have the operating capacity to isolate the organic milk while still taking in milk from their own conventional producers.
