Executive Director Report for March 2025

Legislative/Policy Work

- Organic Dairy Assistance, Investment, and Reporting Yields Act of 2023 (O DAIRY Act of 2023) – Senate Bill 3097
 - 1. Some parts have been included in the Farm Bill proposals
- 2. "The Organic Dairy Data Collection Act" House Bill 6937
 - 1. Full proposal text included in current Farm Bill proposals
- 3. Farm Bill update
 - i. Federal government to remain running at 2024 levels through March 14,2025
 - ii. Farm Bill extended one year (set to expire September 30, 2025)
 - iii. No funding for "orphan programs" including organic certification costshare, the Organic Data Initiative and the Organic Certification Trade & Tracking Program
 - iv. Final 2025 appropriations package is now due to be completed by March
 14th
 - v. 2026 appropriations package is due September 30th
- 4. USDA Funding Freezes & Workforce reductions
 - Programs are being froze, contracts are on pause, farmers are not being paid out currently.
 - 2. So far, 748 lease terminations zeroing in on the 36 NRCS offices, 13 FSA offices and 11 rural housing service offices.
 - i. In our regions:
 - FSA offices: Madera, CA; Bakersfield, CA; Nacogdoches, TX; Clovis, NM; Monticello, UT; Roswell, NM
 - NRCS offices: Yreka, CA; Oxnard, CA; Blythe, CA; Woodland, CA;
 Puyallup, WA; Dayton, WA; Renton, WA; Raton, NM; Gallup, NM;
 Yuma, AZ; Portland, OR; Logan, UT

- 3. OFA is collecting farmer stories to use when speaking with USDA and advocating with members of Congress
- 4. Changing daily
- 5. US doubled tariffs to 50% on Canadian steel and aluminum
 - President Trump is planning to impose a 25% tariff on steel and aluminum coming in from all other countries.
- USDA canceled \$1 billion in local food purchasing for schools and food banks.
 ("Local Food for Schools Cooperative Agreement Program in 2025")
- 5. Avian Influenza Detection and Spread
 - USDA to Begin Accepting Applications for Expanded Emergency Livestock
 Assistance Program to Help Dairy Producers Offset Milk Loss Due to H5N1 |

 Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service
 - 2. Has led to the destruction of more than 166 million birds nationwide.
 - Secretary of Ag (Brooke Rollins) denied approval of vaccine because of ineffectiveness in other countries.
 - 4. Secretary of Health & Human Services (Robert Kennedy Jr.) said federal health agencies under his purview are opposed to poultry vaccines citing lack of sterilizing immunity.
 - i. Confirmed H5N1 positive test results are required for recovery assistance
