1. Call to Order

- It was confirmed that a quorum was present.

2. April Meeting Minute Approval

- Meeting minutes from 04/8/26 were reviewed.

3. Principal's Report

- 357 total 6th graders next year.
- Great job with CASP testing and met the minimum criteria.
- ASB and Allied Action students attended SeaWorld Grad Night. Cost was approximately \$60/student for admission and \$40/student for food. The park closed to the public at 7:00 p.m., with students held in a designated area until 7:45 p.m.; approximately half of the park remained open for the event. Students and staff enjoyed the experience. Discussed SeaWorld as an alternative to Dave & Buster's for future events. Belmont Park was also suggested and would need to be priced out. A daytime trip may be a more cost-effective option.
- 7th Grade – For students who couldn't jump, Skyzone offered mini-golf. Keep in mind for next year.
- Teacher appreciation week was a success and much appreciated by the teachers.

 - **Vote:** Unanimously approved by the board and at-large members
 - **Motion:** Adriana nominated Ellen Immergut for Board Treasurer.
 - **Vote:** Unanimously approved by the board and at-large members
 - **Motion:** Antoni nominated Jenn Mullet for Vice President.
 - **Vote:** Unanimously approved by the board and at-large members
 - **Motion:** Ann nominated Antoni Hanus for President.
 - **Vote:** Unanimously approved by the board and at-large members
 - Challenge Course 2027
 - Friday, April 16th. PE suggested this and the district approved the half day.
 - Working with the yearbook teacher to have students take pictures
 - Insurance doesn't cover events that include inflatables, but the challenge course does not include a jump house. If its company provided, they need to provide the insurance.
 - Teachers need to monitor their students at the end.
 - Challenge Course
 - Just under \$34K raised after fees!
 - Jessica and Amy to lead next year too!
 - Additional budget was needed to cover spent amount.
 - **Motion:** increase line item to \$7500 by Amy, Jessica seconded.
 - **Vote:** Unanimously approved by the board and at-large members.
 - Treasurers Report
 - Refer to treasurer's report in Foundation Presentation slides.
 - 26-27 Budget meeting needs to be before August 1st. Antoni to coordinate.
 - Expenses and checks
 - **Motion:** Ann motioned to approve the checks. **Second:** Jessica seconded.
 - **Vote:** Unanimously approved by board and at-large board members.
 - 6th Grade Camp
 - 298 full time, 11 partial attended! Invoice paid.
 - Next year it's March 22-26, right before spring break.
 - Need (2) coordinators for next year.
 - Dine Outs/Fundraisers
 - \$3443.26!
 - Partnership with Crusaders to provide food trucks for a tournament. The Pershing Foundation will receive the profits.
 - Drama
 - Most successful drama performance on record!
 - \$20K raised and 1131 tickets sold.
 - New Business:
 - Teacher Appreciation
 - Propose doing once a month in lieu of all packed into one week. Coffee truck was a huge hit.
 - 6th grade orientation – August 6th.
