- 2. Academic Enhancements:
 - 1. Science Labs: \$5,000

 - 3. Department Stipends: \$1,000 each, English, Math, PE, SLIM, History
 - 4. Raised Teacher Stipends: \$250 for 2025
 - 5. Student Engagement
 - 1. Field Trip Transportation: \$2,500, each bus costs about \$500
- 3. Operational Sustainability: \$40,000 Reserve, Certificate of Deposit 3.92% 5-Month Term, Matures 01/08/26
- 4. Operation Efficiency: Triple Reward Credit Card, \$25,000 Limit






