## **Featured Projects**

Altis at Promenade, located in Lutz, Florida was completed in 2019 for Altman Contractors, Inc. Approximately 10,800 square feet of pavers were installed at the clubhouse pool area, the roadway entrance and front entry.

The approximate square footage was 10,800. The paver materials used were 8X8 and 16X16 Cream/Beige (Flagstone Pavers), 4X8 and 16X16 Cream/Beige/Charcoal (Flagstone Pavers) and 4X8 Sierra (Tremron).





# **Plantation Walk**

Completed in January 2022 for EHOFDH Development, LLC, this project began in May 2018. Approximately 182,000 square feet of pavers were installed. The materials used were from Oldcastle Coastal in a variety of sizes and colors.

Looking for an eco-friendly solution your hardscape to project? Permeable pavers may be the answer. Permeable pavers allow rainwater to pass around the paver and into the This prevents puddling joints. and flooding, and also filters suspended solids so they don't pollute the water stream.

Unlike regular interlocking pavers that use a sand base, permeable pavers use a base

consisting of crushed aggregate material, like rock, allowing water to soak back into the soil.

### The Enduring Legacy of Martin Luther King, Jr.
