

# Revelation the Architecture

## 7.1-8 144,000 of Israel Sealed 10-31-2021

### Revelation 7. 1-8

<sup>1</sup> And after these things I saw **four angels** standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

<sup>2</sup> And I saw **another angel** ascending from the east, **having the seal of the living God**: and he cried with a loud voice to the **four angels**, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

<sup>3</sup> Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have **sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads**.<sup>4</sup> And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed

an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.<sup>5</sup> Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.<sup>6</sup> Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nephthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.

<sup>7</sup> Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.<sup>8</sup> Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

### Isaiah 11. 11-12

<sup>11</sup> And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.<sup>12</sup> And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

### Matthew 2. 1-2

<sup>1</sup> Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,<sup>2</sup> Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.

### Matthew 24. 27

<sup>27</sup> For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

### Revelation 14. 1-5

<sup>1</sup> And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, **having his Father's name written in their foreheads**.<sup>2</sup> And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps.<sup>3</sup> And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the **four beasts**, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.

<sup>4</sup> These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.<sup>5</sup> And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.

### **Matthew 24. 14**

<sup>14</sup> And this **gospel of the kingdom** shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

### **1 Kings 12. 25-30**

<sup>25</sup> Then Jeroboam built Shechem in mount Ephraim, and dwelt therein; and went out from thence, and built Penuel.<sup>26</sup> And Jeroboam said in his heart, Now shall the kingdom return to the house of David:<sup>27</sup> If this people go up to do sacrifice in the house of the LORD at Jerusalem, then shall the heart of this people turn again unto their lord, even unto Rehoboam king of Judah, and they shall kill me, and go again to Rehoboam king of Judah.<sup>28</sup> Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves of gold, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.<sup>29</sup> And he set the one in Bethel, and the other put he in Dan.<sup>30</sup> And this thing became a sin: for the people went to worship before the one, even unto Dan.

### **Hosea 4. 17**

<sup>17</sup> Ephraim is joined to idols: let him alone.

### **Ezekiel 48. 1-7, 23-27**

<sup>1</sup> Now these are the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east and west; a portion for Dan.<sup>2</sup> And by the border of Dan, from the east side unto the west side, a portion for Asher.<sup>3</sup> And by the border of Asher, from the east side even unto the west side, a portion for Naphtali.<sup>4</sup> And by the border of Naphtali, from the east side unto the west side, a portion for Manasseh.<sup>5</sup> And by the border of Manasseh, from the east side unto the west side, a portion for Ephraim.<sup>6</sup> And by the border of Ephraim, from the east side even unto the west side, a portion for Reuben.<sup>7</sup> And by the border of Reuben, from the east side unto the west side, a portion for Judah.

<sup>23</sup> As for the rest of the tribes, from the east side unto the west side, Benjamin shall have a portion.

<sup>24</sup> And by the border of Benjamin, from the east side unto the west side, Simeon shall have a portion.

<sup>25</sup> And by the border of Simeon, from the east side unto the west side, Issachar a portion.

<sup>26</sup> And by the border of Issachar, from the east side unto the west side, Zebulun a portion.

<sup>27</sup> And by the border of Zebulun, from the east side unto the west side, Gad a portion.

### **Ezekiel 48. 31-34**

<sup>31</sup> And the gates of the city shall be after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.<sup>32</sup> And at the east side four thousand and five hundred: and three gates; and one gate of Joseph, one gate of Benjamin, one gate of Dan.

<sup>33</sup> And at the south side four thousand and five hundred measures: and three gates; one gate of Simeon, one gate of Issachar, one gate of Zebulun.<sup>34</sup> At the west side four thousand and five hundred, with their three gates; one gate of Gad, one gate of Asher, one gate of Naphtali.

### **Revelation 9. 1-4**

<sup>1</sup> And the **fifth angel** sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.<sup>2</sup> And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.<sup>3</sup> And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.<sup>4</sup> And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but **only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.**

### **Revelation 3. 12**

<sup>12</sup> Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and **I will write upon him the name of my God,** and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: **and I will write upon him my new name.**

### **Revelation 22. 3-4**

<sup>3</sup> And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:<sup>4</sup> And they shall see his face; and **his name shall be in their foreheads.**

### **Revelation 13. 16-17**

<sup>16</sup> And **he causeth all,** both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, **to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:**<sup>17</sup> And that no man might buy or sell, save **he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.**

### **Revelation 14. 9-11**

<sup>9</sup> And the **third angel** followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship **the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,**<sup>10</sup> The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:<sup>11</sup> And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, **and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.**

### **Revelation 15. 1-2**

<sup>1</sup> And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, **seven angels** having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.<sup>2</sup> And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the **victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name,** stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

### **Revelation 16. 1-2**

<sup>1</sup> And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the **seven angels**, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth.

<sup>2</sup> And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the **men which had the mark of the beast**, and upon them which worshipped his image.

### **Revelation 19. 20**

<sup>20</sup> And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had **received the mark of the beast**, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

### **Revelation 20. 4**

<sup>4</sup> And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, **neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands**; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

### **Matthew 24. 9**

<sup>9</sup> Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.
