Revelation the Architecture 9. 1-21 Fifth & Sixth Trumpets 11-21-2021

Revelation 8. 13

13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, **Woe, woe, woe**, to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

Revelation 9. 1-21

- **1** And the <u>fifth angel</u> sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.
- **2** And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.
- **3** And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.
- **4** And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which <u>have not the seal of God in their foreheads</u>.
- **5** And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.
- **6** And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them.
- **7** And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men.
- 8 And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as the teeth of lions.
- **9** And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.
- **10** And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men five months.
- **11** And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon.
- 12 One woe is past; and, behold, there come two woes more hereafter.
- **13** And the <u>sixth angel</u> sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,
- **14** Saying to the <u>sixth angel</u> which had the trumpet, Loose the <u>four angels</u> which are bound in the great river Euphrates.
- **15** And the <u>four angels</u> were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.
- **16** And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.
- **17** And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.
- **18** By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

- **19** For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails were like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.
- **20** And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:
- **21** Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Revelation 8. 7

7 The <u>first angel</u> sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

Hebrews 2.14

14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

Exodus 10. 14

14 And the locusts went up over all the land of Egypt, and rested in all the coasts of Egypt: very grievous were they; before them there were no such locusts as they, neither after them shall be such.

Proverbs 30. 27

27 The locusts have no king, yet go they forth all of them by bands;

Revelation 11. 14

14 The <u>second woe</u> is past; and, behold, the <u>third woe</u> cometh quickly.

Revelation 16. 12, 16

12 And the <u>sixth angel</u> poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.

Genesis 19. 24

24 Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven;

Revelation 19. 20

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Revelation 20. 10

10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Revelation 21.8

8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

Revelation 10. 6-7

6 And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer:

7 But in the days of the voice of the <u>seventh angel</u>, when he shall <u>begin to sound</u>, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

Revelation 11. 13-15

13 And the same hour was there a <u>great earthquake</u>, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

14 The <u>second woe</u> is past; and, behold, the <u>third woe</u> cometh quickly.

15 And the <u>seventh angel</u> sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Revelation 12. 12

12 Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.
