Revelation – the Architecture Intro. / Rev. 1:10-20 5-2-2021

Revelation 1. 10-20

- 10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,
- ¹¹ Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.
- ¹² And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;
- ¹³ And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.
- ¹⁴ His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;
- ¹⁵ And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.
- ¹⁶ And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.
- ¹⁷ And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:
- ¹⁸ I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.
- ¹⁹ Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter:
- ²⁰ The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

Revelation 4. 1

¹ After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

1 Corinthians 15. 51-52

- ⁵¹ Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- ⁵² In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1 Thessalonians 4. 16-18

- ¹⁶ For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
- ¹⁷ Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
- ¹⁸ Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

John 1. 4, 6-9

- ⁴ In him was life; and the life was the light of men.
- ⁶ There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.
- ⁷ The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.
- ⁸ He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.
- ⁹ That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

John 8. 12

¹² Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

John 9. 5

⁵ As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

Ephesians 5. 8

⁸ For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

Luke 19. 10

¹⁰ For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

1 Peter 1. 13

¹³ Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

- ¹ And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:
- ⁵ And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.

Daniel 7. 9, 13

- ⁹ I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.
- ¹³ I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

Colossians 2. 8-9

- ⁸ Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.
- ⁹ For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Isaiah 9. 6

⁶ For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

<u>John 14. 6-11</u>

- ⁶ Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- ⁷ If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.
- ⁸ Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.
- ⁹ Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?
- ¹⁰ Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.
- ¹¹ Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

Ezekiel 43. 2

² And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory.

Hebrews 1. 4, 13-14

- ⁴ Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.
- ¹³ But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? ¹⁴ Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Matthew 18. 5-6, 10

- ⁵ And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me. ⁶ But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.
- ¹⁰ Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.

¹² For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Ephesians 6. 17

¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

- ¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- ² The same was in the beginning with God.
- ¹⁴ And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Malachi 4. 2

² But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Matthew 17. 1-2

- ¹ And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,
- ² And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

Acts 9. 1-5, 8-9

- ¹ And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest,
- ² And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.
- ³ And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:

² Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God.

⁹ I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

⁴ And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

⁵ And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

⁸ And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought him into Damascus.

⁹ And he was three days without sight, and neither did eat nor drink.
