ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

ENROLLMENT FOR 2026

We at IMBITA SCHOOL sincerely thank you for making the right decision with regards to your child's education.

- 1. The attached form should be brought back with a non-refundable registration fee of R900 and the following:
 - · A copy of the child's birth certificate. (All applicants)
 - · A recent report from your school. (Grade 1 to Grade 9 only)
 - A transfer letter from the previous school. (Grade 1 to Grade 9 only)
 - An ID /Passport size photo. (All applicants)
 - · A parent or both parents ID copies. (All applicants)
 - · An amount of R250 for school ID card and memorial photos.
- Learners born in the year 2019 will be accepted for grade 1. An interview will be given as to ascertain their aptitude and readiness.
- 3. We accept children from the age 3 years for grade zero (Pre-school).
- 4. English is offered as our medium of instruction; Sepedi is studied as a second language.
- 5. All fees are paid at the bank, or you can swipe at the school; no cash is accepted at the school
- 6. All monies should be paid in advance (that is before or on the 5th of every month).
 Late payment will attract a penalty of 5%
- 7. Parents with two or more children will enjoy a 10 % discount on fees per learner.
- 9. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances either in cash or any form.
- 10. All educational tours are compulsory for all learners.
- 11. Proper school uniform is to be worn; no multi or non-school emblem clothing will be accepted at the school. (Uniform is sold at the school).
- Personal financial constraints of parents will not be accepted as an excuse for non-payments.
- 13. We request parents to fill forms sincerely and never give us non existing numbers.

Signing of the application form should be binding and constitute an acceptance of the school rules.

CODE OF CONDUCT

ACADEMIC WORK

- Cheating on tests, homework and any other classwork is dishonourable behaviour. Any form of cheating is regarded as a serious offense.
- · Learners are expected to catch up work missed due to absence.

OFF-SCHOOL EVENTS AND TOURS

- Learners are bound by provision of the code of conduct, to behave well in sporting and cultural activities.
- Learners must still behave in accordance with the code of conduct as long as they are wearing the school uniform, even off the school premises.
- Courteous behaviour and good sportsmanship are required at all times, whether on of off the school premises, and whether wearing the school uniform or not.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

BULLYING

• Learners must not engage in any intentional malicious damage or defacing of the school's premises, property or equipment.

· Learners cannot possess or look for pornographic material.

LEARNERS' APPEARANCE

- Learners must keep their hair clean and tidy at all times. Girls must keep hair cropped or closely braided.

GENERAL BEHAVIOUR


- · Learners must respect fellow learners at all times
