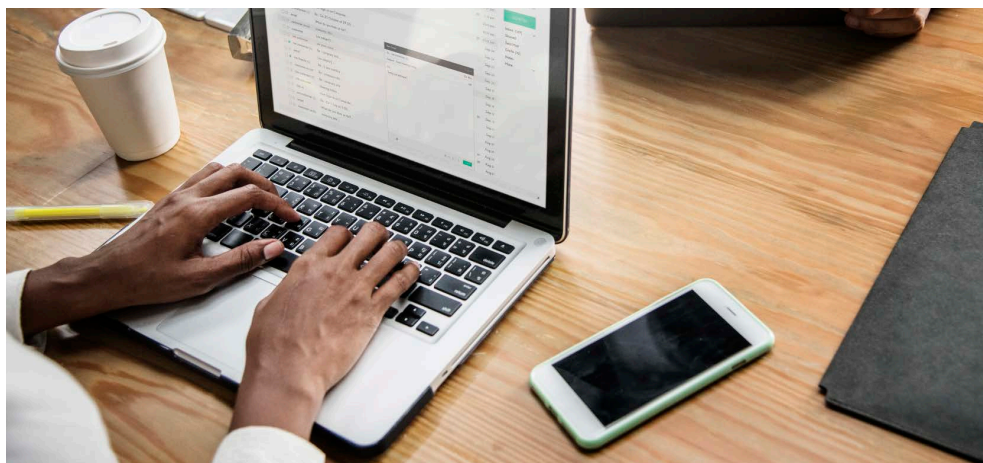

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

ENROLLMENT FOR 2026

We at IMBITA SCHOOL sincerely thank you for making the right decision with regards to your child's education.

1. The attached form should be brought back with a non-refundable registration fee of **R900** and the following:
 - A copy of the child's birth certificate. (All applicants)
 - A recent report from your school. (Grade 1 to Grade 9 only)
 - A transfer letter from the previous school. (Grade 1 to Grade 9 only)
 - An ID /Passport size photo. (All applicants)
 - A parent or both parents ID copies. (All applicants)
 - An amount of **R250** for school ID card and memorial photos.
2. Learners born in the year 2019 will be accepted for grade 1. An interview will be given as to ascertain their aptitude and readiness.
3. We accept children from the age 3 years for grade zero (Pre-school).
4. English is offered as our medium of instruction; Sepedi is studied as a second language.
5. All fees are paid at the bank, or you can swipe at the school; no cash is accepted at the school.
6. All monies should be paid in advance (that is before or on the 5th of every month). Late payment will attract a penalty of 5%
7. Parents with two or more children will enjoy a 10 % discount on fees per learner.
9. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances either in cash or any form.
10. All educational tours are compulsory for all learners.
11. Proper school uniform is to be worn; no multi or non-school emblem clothing will be accepted at the school. (Uniform is sold at the school).
12. Personal financial constraints of parents will not be accepted as an excuse for non-payments.
13. We request parents to fill forms sincerely and never give us non existing numbers.

Signing of the application form should be binding and constitute an acceptance of the school rules.

CODE OF CONDUCT

ACADEMIC WORK

- Cheating on tests , homework and any other classwork is dishonourable behaviour. Any form of cheating is regarded as a serious offense.
- Learners are expected to catch up work missed due to absence.

OFF-SCHOOL EVENTS AND TOURS

- Learners are bound by provision of the code of conduct, to behave well in sporting and cultural activities.
- Learners must still behave in accordance with the code of conduct as long as they are wearing the school uniform, even off the school premises.
- Courteous behaviour and good sportsmanship are required at all times, whether on or off the school premises, and whether wearing the school uniform or not.
- All other school rules and regulations will still apply when away on class tours or excursions.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

- Learners may not in any day use drugs or consume alcohol, whether on or off school, wearing school uniform or not.
- Learners may not possess any illegal or unauthorised substances, if that is suspected they will be searched to confirm and further disciplinary steps will be taken.
- Learners are not allowed to smoke at any time. Any learner in possession of cigarettes or holding one , lit or not, is deemed to be smoking.

THEFT

- Any form of theft will not be tolerated, and may result in a search of a learner's person.

BULLYING

- Learners must not engage in any form of bullying, victimization, fighting, intimidation, racism, sexual harassment or religious and cultural intolerance.
- No fireworks, firearms or ammunition will be brought into the school premises.

VANDALISM

- Learners must not engage in any intentional malicious damage or defacing of the school's premises, property or equipment.

PORNOGRAPHIC MATERIAL

- Learners cannot possess or look for pornographic material.

CODE OF CONDUCT

LEARNERS' APPEARANCE

- Learners must keep their hair clean and tidy at all times. Girls must keep hair cropped or closely braided.
- All Learners are not allowed to wear any jewellery other than watches. Girls may wear "sleepers" if their ears are pierced (Only one per ear). Jewellery that has cultural or religious significance can be worn, but must be concealed under clothes for safety, during physical activities.
- Uniform may not be altered unless, for normal and or reasonable size adjustments.

GENERAL BEHAVIOUR

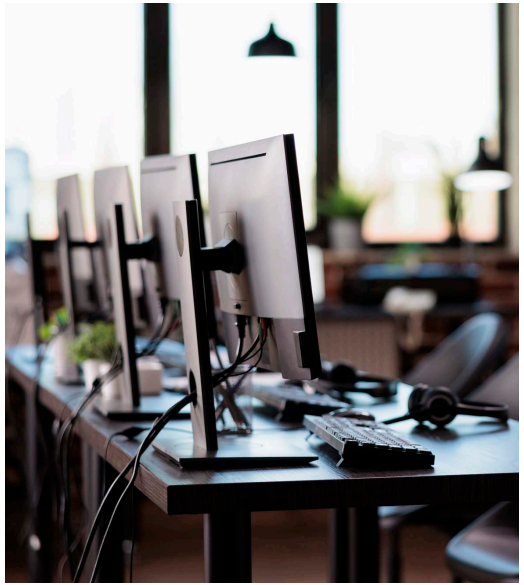
- Learners must respect fellow learners at all times
