### TRAFFIC CALMING EFFORTS CONTINUED

Traffic Calming – 50%+ Association Agreement



You may remember in the spring newsletter; we talked about what we were doing to reduce speeding within the community. The path included education, gathering data and now consensus. To that end, we will be providing an opportunity for the community to vote to invite the county to assist in installing traffic calming devices, or not.

Mid-2023 collected traffic data indicates vehicles are making more than 6,000 passes on our 3 main roads every week, and better than 40% of them are speeding! At that time, school wasn't in session. It is anticipated that the numbers are higher now.

Only a fourth of our development has sidewalks (most of which are on side streets), and there are no streetlights, which means children, elderly, dogs, cats, and you walk on roads with motorists driving way too fast for conditions.

The county has a competitive program to help calm things down, and the board would like to take advantage of the opportunity. To compete we must have 50+ percent of the association agree to participate in the program, and if successful, to allow the county to install traffic calming devices, speed humps, traffic circles, chicanes or something similar.

Community members will have the opportunity to vote on this decision. We will be setting up electronic voting. For those who are not technically savvy, please drop us a note to indicate you agree or disagree the association should participate/compete in the program.

#### **AUTUMN LANDSCAPING TIPS**

- Autumn is the best time to fertilize your lawn.
- · Aerate if you did not this spring.
- Attack the dandelions- you will have the most impact this time of year.
- Rather than raking, mow your leaves until they are finely chopped. They will quickly decompose and add to the soil's nutrients.

#### **RECIPE**

Italian Meatball Soup
Quick and Hearty

#### Ingredients

- 1. 1 tsp olive oil
- 2. ½ cup onion finely chopped
- 3. 2 stalks celery sliced
- 4. 2 carrots peeled and diced
- 5. 15 oz crushed tomatoes





- 6. 16 oz can tomato sauce
- 7. 6 cups beef broth
- 8. 1 tsp dried Italian seasoning
- 9. Salt and pepper to taste
- 10. 3/4 cup short pasta such as ditalini
- 11. 2 tbs fresh parsley, chopped.
- 12. Parmesan cheese for serving
- 13. Meatballs
- 14. 20 oz or roughly 18 small frozen or premade meatballs. Cook according to package directions or add directly if precooked. This shortcut makes this a quick and delicious soup.

#### Instructions:

- · Heat the olive oil in a large pot over medium heat.
- · Add celery, carrots and onions.
- · Cook for 4 to 5 minutes.
- Add the crushed tomatoes, tomato sauce, broth, Italian seasoning, salt and pepper.
- · Bring to a simmer.
- · Add meatballs and pasta to the pot.
- Simmer for 10 minutes or until veggies and pasta are tender.
- Top with parsley and parmesan cheese, and enjoy!
