Key Responsibilities:

- Carry out in-flight training in accordance with the Company Operations Manual Volume 3.
- Carry out Line Competency Checks in accordance with Operations Manual Volume 3.
- Ensure that the standards and procedures for initial, recurrent and conversion training are followed at all times and are conducted in accordance with Company performance criteria.
- Ensure that all Cabin Crew under Training or Check are briefed on their flight requirements before the commencement of the exercise or duties.
- Ensure that all Cabin Crew are debriefed after Training and Check flight completion.
- Ensure that the necessary training and check reports are produced and passed to the Senior Training Cabin Crew on completion.
- Ensure that Operations Control is made aware of the availability of Cabin Crew following the completion of training or checking exercises.
- Assess and check the knowledge of Cabin Crew on the aircraft equipment location and functions.
- Ensure that Cabin Crew maintain the standards of conduct and appearance required by the Company.
- Ensure that all Ground and Flight Training and Checking of Cabin Crew are carried out in accordance with the Company Operations Manual Volume 3.
- Comply with all relevant manuals; particularly the Human Resources Policies and Procedures Manual.

- Perform such other duties as may be reasonably required as commensurate with the position.

Required Qualifications and Experience:

- Must have 2 years experience as a LIAT Cabin Crew
- Must have successfully completed the training course described in the Operations Manual Volume 3 Section 2 Chapter 13
