

### **Journey in Faith**

Journey in Faith is for those who might be interested in becoming Catholics, as well as for Catholics who want to deepen their own knowledge of the Catholic Faith. At the sessions we use a resource called 'Evangelium' which was developed by two Priests from the Archdiocese of Westminster. This resource uses Christian art throughout the centuries to help us understand better our Faith. The sessions use Power Point presentations, and there is also time for questions and discussion. Refreshments are also provided. Over the past couple of years, I have run these sessions on a Wednesday evening up in the Hall at St Peter's, and we have formed a really good group. I know some of the group are preparing to begin the sessions again, because the Catholic Faith is so rich there is always more to learn! Having listened to feedback from some parishioners who would like to come but have been unable for one reason or another, I have decided for the coming year to move the sessions to the Parish Centre at St James the Less and also to move them to a Thursday evening. The first session which is on 'The Meaning of Life' will take place in the Parish Centre at St James the Less on Thursday 27th February at 7.00pm.
