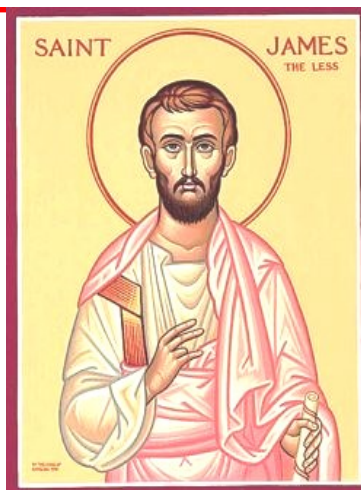

### Sacramental Programme

Our children from St Joseph's and St Peter's received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time last Tuesday - a beautiful celebration of the Lord's mercy and forgiveness. This coming Tuesday, 18th March, the children from St James the Less will make their First Confession at 4.30pm, so please pray for them as take this important step on their journey to First Holy Communion in June. The First Confession of the children is a good reminder to each one of us to make a good Confession in this Season of Lent. Just as the Church asks us to attend Mass on Sundays and on Holy Days, so also each of us is expected to attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year, and to attend the Sacrament if we are conscious of a serious sin before we receive Holy Communion again. If you have not been to Confession for a long time, there is no need to be anxious - I will help and guide you through the Sacrament. Regular use of this beautiful Sacrament brings a lot of peace and joy to our lives and gives us the opportunity for a fresh start and a new beginning.
