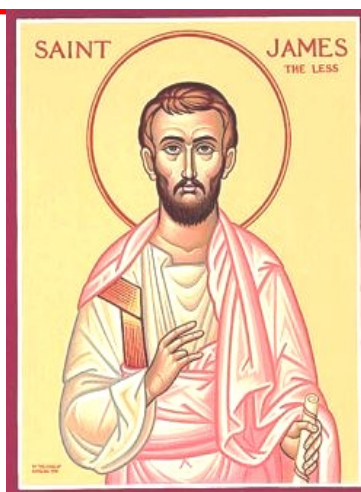

Update on Parish Centre

The works on the Parish Centre were scheduled to be completed by this coming Wednesday, 24th July. Unfortunately, as is often the case with these projects, there are a couple of delays. Firstly, two of the walls have been plastered with a special lime plaster, and this cannot be painted over for some weeks yet as it has not fully dried out. The re-carpeting has also yet to be completed and the installation of the new sound system, amplifier etc. It may be that we can open the Centre before the decoration is fully complete as the drying out of the lime plaster is likely to take us to the beginning of September, but we will certainly not be opened, as I had initially hoped, by the first weekend in August. I have to say that because of the insurance angle, this has not been a straightforward project. At each stage, we have had to get approval from the loss adjuster so that we can claim on the Parish insurance for the work where this has been like-for-like repairs as a result of the flood. At the same time, we have been paying for certain things ourselves where this has entailed improvements which are not like-for-like. I will be very grateful when it is finally finished, as I know you all will be! Even after we re-open, there will be some improvements we may have to look at carrying out afterwards, to the conservatory and to the entrance porch. Thank you for your patience which I am sure will all be worth it once we re-open!
