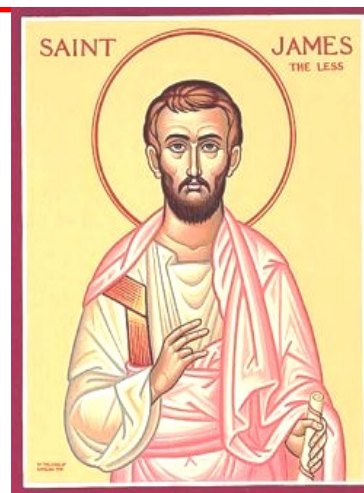

Dear Friends,

I wanted to take this opportunity to say a big thank you to all who helped in any way to prepare for the Liturgies of Holy Week and Easter this year in the Parish of Holy Apostles. Sincere thanks to the Sisters who were a big help this year in preparing and setting everything up; my thanks also to the church cleaners, the flower arrangers, the Altar Servers, the Readers, our musicians and singers, the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and volunteers who had their feet washed on Maundy Thursday. My thanks to you all for attending all of the Liturgies of the Easter Triduum in such good numbers and for really entering into the Mystery of God's love for us in Holy Week.

On Maundy Thursday, we celebrated together the great Gifts given to us by Our Lord at the Last Supper - the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist and the Sacrament of the Sacred Priesthood. On Good Friday we celebrated the Sacrifice of Love on Calvary for our salvation, and at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday and the Easter Masses on Sunday morning, we celebrate the Resurrection of Our Lord.
