Parish Sisters

Our Parish Sisters, the Teaching Sisters of St Dorothy, Daughters of the Sacred Heart, are settling well into our Parish and I know many of you are already getting to know them. Sister Princy will be working mostly with me in Parish work. Over the coming weeks and months, she will be getting involved with meeting with parents enquiring about Baptism, the Sacramental Programme children, catechesis for our young people preparing for Confirmation, visits to the sick and housebound and also involvement with our three Primary Schools and our High School. This is an appeal for Parish volunteers to help me ensure Sister can get fully involved in all of this. Currently, she has a provisional driving license. If anyone knows of a local, friendly and patient driving instructor who they could recommend, could you please pass his or her details onto me. Also, in the meantime, whilst Sister learns to drive over here, could I ask for any volunteers who would be able to help from time to time with transporting Sister. Once I have taken her around myself, she will need in the short term some help getting to our Primary Schools and being collected; coming up to some of the 9am Sunday Masses in St Peter's; visits to the sick and housebound in the Parish covering the areas of Crawshaw Booth, Rawtenstall, (mostly in the Balladen) Newchurch and Stacksteads. If any parishioners would be able to help with this, please do let me know. Your help would be much appreciated. This would only be in the short term because, as stated above, Sister will be learning to drive herself in the coming months. Please keep our Sisters in your prayers. I am very pleased they are here with us and I know they will be a blessing to our Parish.
