

# REPORTING ON MAJOR PLATFORMS



## 1. FIND THE POST, MESSAGE, OR ACCOUNT

Go to the post, comment, message, or profile showing harm. Take screenshots if you can.

## 2. TAP THE THREE DOTS (...)

Look for the three dots (...) at the top right of a post or video, next to a comment or on a profile page.

## 3. TAP "REPORT"

## 4. CHOOSE THE REASON

Examples include: Harassment or bullying, Threats or violence, Impersonation

## 5. SUBMIT (AND OPTIONAL: BLOCK)

Follow the on-screen steps and submit your report. You may also be prompted to Block or Restrict the account.



## 1. FIND THE POST OR ACCOUNT

Locate the post (tweet), reply, direct message, or profile. Take screenshots for your records.

## 2. TAP THE THREE DOTS (...)

You can find the three dots on a post, user's profile, or in a message thread.

## 3. TAP "REPORT"

## 4. SELECT THE VIOLATION

Choose the option that best fits, such as: Abusive or harmful conduct, Hate or harassment

## 5. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AND SUBMIT

Complete any follow-up questions and submit the report.

# REPORTING ON MAJOR PLATFORMS



## 1. FIND THE VIDEO, COMMENT, OR ACCOUNT

Go to the video, comment, message, or profile involved. Take screenshots if you can.

## 2. TAP "SHARE" OR THE THREE DOTS (...)

On videos: tap Share (arrow icon); on comments or profiles: tap the three dots (...)

## 3. TAP "REPORT"

## 4. CHOOSE A CATEGORY

Common options include: Harassment or hateful behavior, Impersonation

## 5. SUBMIT

Follow instructions and submit the report. You may also be able to block the account.

## 1. FIND THE VIDEO, COMMENT, OR CHANNEL

Open the video, comment, or channel page showing harm. Take screenshots if needed.

## 2. TAP THE THREE DOTS (...)

## 3. TAP "REPORT"

## 4. SELECT THE ISSUE

Options may include: Harassment or cyberbullying, Hate speech, Threats

## 5. SUBMIT

Complete the form and submit your report. You can also hide or block users from your channel.
