History of Montebello

During the Civil War, forts were built on the land as part of the chain of defenses of Washington on the Virginia hills overlooking the Potomac River. Once home to native tribes and explorers, the area was owned by land speculators in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. Lord Bryan Fairfax, a friend of George Washington who supported the General but favored peace over war, purchased a sizeable parcel in 1789 and built a home for his family, naming it Mount Eagle after consulting with Washington on the name.

In November 1979, International Developers, Inc. (IDI) purchased 35 acres of the former Mount Eagle property to build luxury condominiums. IDI owner Guiseppe Cecchi paid tribute to his Italian heritage by naming the complex "Montebello" which means beautiful mountain.
