Cooking from the Pantry **Chicken Tortilla Dump Dinner**

1 tablespoon canola oil Two 10-ounce cans diced tomatoes with chiles 1 cup chicken broth 1 tablespoon chili powder 1 teaspoon ground cumin 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt 5 cups shredded cooked chicken (from about 1 12 One 10-ounce bag frozen corn small corn tortillas, cut up small rotisserie chicken) One 15.5-ounce can black beans, drained and rinsed One 8-ounce block Monterey Jack cheese, shredded (about 2 cups) 1/3 cup diced red onion 1/2 cup sour cream 1/3 cup loosely packed fresh cilantro, chopped



Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F. Brush a 9-by-13-inch casserole dish with the oil.

Stir together the diced tomatoes with chiles, chicken broth, chili powder, cumin and salt in a large bowl. Add the black beans, frozen corn, chicken, tortilla wedges and half the cheese and stir to evenly distribute and moisten all of the ingredients. Transfer to the prepared casserole dish and spread into an even layer. Loosely cover with aluminum foil and bake for 25 minutes.

Raise the oven temperature to 400 degrees F. Remove the foil and sprinkle the top with the remaining cheese. Continue to bake until the cheese is melted and just starting to brown, about 10 minutes. Top with dollops of sour cream and sprinkle with the red onion and cilantro. Serve hot

Problems Associated With 'Too Big' ACs Using an oversized AC, in our opinion, may be even more damaging and inefficient.

This major problem is short-cycling. Short-

cycling means that your unit will cool your home-space too guickly, switch off and turn on again when need be. This vicious cycle will not allow your appliance to run continuously for the time it requires to dehumidify your air and filter it properly. This will result in undesirable moisture content in your atmosphere which can compromise your comfort level greatly and lead to irritability in the summer heat.

Moreover, needing a kick-start very often in a single day and running more frequently for shorter periods of time will drastically increase energy usage and wastage. This will increase your utility costs, the very costs you had hoped to avoid by investing heavily in a large AC unit.
