Thursday June 20, 2019 - Horsemanship - Rodeo

- Horsemanship will begin at 9:00 am at the Siloam Springs Rodeo Grounds
- Queen and Princess patterns are attached to this document
- The reining Queen and Princess will demonstrate the pattern before each division.
- Lunch is provided for the contestants at Callahan's Steak House in Siloam Springs following horsemanship (Parents are responsible for their own meal)
- Rodeo grand entry at 7:45pm

Friday June 21, 2019 Special Kids Rodeo – Speech and Modeling – Rodeo

- Special Kids Rodeo at the Siloam Springs Rodeo Grounds at 9:30
- Pizza lunch following the Special Kids Rodeo before Modeling
- Speech and Modeling will be from 12:00 3:00 (Location to be Determined)
- Rodeo grand entry at 7:45pm

Saturday June 22, 2019 Rodeo Parade – Rodeo

- Siloam Springs Rodeo Parade starts at 10:00am
 - Meet behind Atwoods in the Intermediate School Parking Lot
- Rodeo grand entry at 7:45pm
- Coronation during the rodeo
 - A previous outfit can be worn for coronation

If any contestant is not at the designated area ready for the competition event, they will be given a 10 point penalty on their score.

<u>Rules</u>

- At no point during a judged event during the royalty pageant should a contestant be on a phone
 - Parents, please be mindful and courteous of cellphone disruption at events as well.
- Personal Interviews: Contestants will go in order of their drawn numbers, one at a time to meet with the Judges to be asked questions. Questions can range from Siloam Springs Rodeo information, rodeo events, horse information to impromptu random questions for reaction.
- Modeling & Speeches: The contestants will model as their biographies are read, followed by the
 delivery of their speech to the judges and audience. They will then answer impromptu questions
 before leaving the stage.
 - Parents or trainers are not allowed to have contact with contestants during modeling, speeches or interviews until contestants are released.
- Horsemanship: Each contestant will present the attached pattern for judging. Horsemanship will begin promptly at 9:00am, please be mounted and at the gate waiting for instruction.
 - Dress code for horsemanship is
 - Blue Jeans
 - White Western Shirt
 - Hat
 - Belt
 - Boots
 - No chaps or gloves allowed
 - Contestants are expected to groom and tack their own horse
 - Princess contestants are allowed assistance but are expected to do as much as they can
 - Parents and trainers are not allowed to have contact with the contestants in the waiting area until they have completed the patterns and have been released.
 - Nobody except the contestant is allowed to ride or warm up the contestant's horse
 - No coaching from the rail (if caught a 50-point penalty will result)
 - If at any time it appears a contestant is out of control of their horse and/or a danger is observed a whistle will be blown to stop the current pattern.
- Reigning royalty is required to wear their crown, banner and western attire throughout the Siloam Springs Rodeo and when at a public event representing the Siloam Springs Rodeo.
