



Prayer Request from Nehre Family at WNS



Thank you for praying for peace in Kenya this past week. After a day off of school on Tuesday, strikes were called off late Tuesday and discussions have taken place about fuel costs. Gasoline prices jumped by nearly a dollar a gallon prior to the strikes. In Kenya, prices are regulated by the government and prices are reevaluated twice a month. While costs have risen around the world, this change was quite the leap not just in gasoline, but also diesel. There has also been corruption in the fuel industry with illegal mixing of gasoline with kerosene and with delivering substandard fuels.

While talks with political and transportation leaders have gone on this week, there has also been threats of continued strikes this coming Monday and/or Tuesday.

Would you please pray the strikes do not take place this week? Strikes disrupt daily life, bring other violence (there were several deaths on Monday) and bring the trauma of past events. We would love to be able to finish out the last days of the school year (including finishing high school final exams) without another school closure or have parents afraid to send their kids to school.

Today was the graduation ceremony for the class of 2026. This group of 25 kids are a diverse bunch. 4 of them attended WNS from kindergarten through 12th grade. They will go on to study in 10 different countries next year. We had two valedictorians with GPAs over 4.5 and two salutatorians! They are artists, athletes, scholars, leaders, musicians, worship leaders, debaters, and researchers. The gospel was presented numerous times in today's graduation program, speaking to the great need for many of these young adults to choose a relationship with Christ. There were also graduates who boldly proclaimed the distinct role God has had in their life, and how their time at WNS has helped shape their Biblical Worldview. Please pray for these young men and women as they step into something new.

Lastly, would you please pray ahead of our travels next Friday & Saturday. We will enter the US via Chicago Saturday morning. Would you specifically pray for a smooth entry for all 5 of us and that if there are questions about Joshua's passport / paperwork / history, that we would be able to answer them well?
