




#### M & M Scholarship Committee

Dear Family of God,

We are eagerly anticipating the Lenten season and along with it, Lenten Lunches at First Baptist Church. It is a blessed and holy time of year. In the Lenten season we remember and meditate on the sufferings of the Suffering Servant, Jesus Christ.

First Baptist Church has been holding Lenten Lunches for over forty years, except for a two-year hiatus due to public health concerns. Thank you to all the volunteers who are helping out again. For six Mondays we will have Lenten Lunches, including a meal and a worship service. The dates are February 19, 26; and March 4, 11, 18, 25. Doors open at 11:30 a.m. for each of the six luncheon dates. Our theme this year is *The Seven Last Sayings of Jesus from the Cross*. This is a very familiar theme if you are familiar with the Bible.

On Sunday mornings in the new year, I have begun a series called "Route 66." There are sixty-six books in the Bible. I will be preaching one- or two-week summaries on each of those sixty-six books. Now that I am over Covid and hoping for no more Sunday morning blizzards, we should be able to make good progress in this new sermon series.

As I preach through Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, etc., I will not interrupt the Route 66 series to preach on Lenten themes. If you attend Lenten Lunches you will hear messages about Jesus' suffering, death, and resurrection. On Palm Sunday, the scripture readings will be focused on Jesus' triumphal entry, but not the sermon. Likewise, on Easter/Resurrection Sunday, the scripture reading will be focused on Jesus' resurrection, but not the sermon.

On February 5-9, I will be preaching on KOKX at around 6:00 a.m. Those messages will be about Jesus' sufferings, death, and resurrection.

Oh, and by the way, please don't hesitate to call me during the week. I would be happy to pray over the phone with you. We could also set up a time to meet at the church. I want to get to know you all better. The hours that I am in the office are Mondays through Thursdays, 7:00 - 3:00. After 3:00 you might find me at McDonald's, meeting people in the community, working on my sermon, etc. I take Fridays off. On Saturdays, I usually come to the church with Lisa at 11:00 to sit in on the music team rehearsal. It has become a nice worship time that I use as a preparation of my heart for Sunday worship. If you can't make it to the worship service on Sunday, then come and join me and the music team at the rehearsal. Eleven o'clock Saturday.

Have a great February. Let's stay in God's word, stay out of sin, keep our eyes on Jesus. We serve the Suffering Servant of Isaiah, who is also the Risen Christ!


