

# Pastor Bob's Corner



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Time Flies. It was Advent and Christmas, and suddenly I'm preparing for Lent and Lenten Lunches! How is your Bible reading going? Prior to the New Year, I urged all who were in the worship services to plan on reading the Bible in the New Year.

Are you discouraged that you have fallen behind and probably won't be able to read through the whole Bible in 2026? If so, don't beat yourself up. Instead of trying to catch up, how about if you commit to reading just the four Gospels—Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—in 2026. Or read the Proverb of the Day? If the date is the 18<sup>th</sup>, then read Proverbs 18. It is convenient that there are 31 Proverbs, one for each day of the month.

I would like to invite you to the worship service each week. It is still happening at 10:20 a.m. on Sunday mornings. Some of you do not attend worship because you have to work, or your health is not good, or you are afraid of the icy sidewalks and roads. Those are valid reasons to miss the worship service.

What is not valid in this regard is to never come to church, and plead idle excuses for not attending. For example, some say, "I can worship just as well while I go hunting, fishing, shopping, etc." If this is your attitude, you have missed Jesus. He is waiting and present in the sanctuary of all good churches.

If you go deer hunting, you have to go where the deer are most likely to be found. Don't wait around for a buck to be in a parking lot. Deer are most likely to be found in the woods. Likewise, Jesus is most likely to be found in the Lord's House on the Lord's Day. Are you there with him?

What excuses do you have? We do not pass an offering plate; money is the least of our concerns. Dress casually, but modestly.

For the past five years, on Mondays through Thursdays, I have come into the church at 7:00 a.m. The first thing I do is a prayer walk in the sanctuary. I have prayed for you. The prayer I have prayed the most is just below,

**Hebrews 10:25 (NLT)—"And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near."**

To those of you who are faithful on Sunday mornings, and at other times, keep seeking Jesus there.

**2Timothy 4:1-2—(ESV)—"I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: <sup>2</sup> preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching."**

5. Gently stir and garnish with strawberries.


**OPTIONAL**
