Pastor's Corner

May, 2022

Dear Church Family,

Jesus is risen, he is risen indeed! Hallelujah! As I write this letter it is two days after our resurrection/Easter service. I got to experience my first Lenten Lunches, and they are over for another year. I enjoyed those services as we met with believers from many other churches. For six consecutive Mondays we had the opportunity to prepare for the remembrance of Jesus' suffering and death, and the celebration of his resurrection! Amen.

What now? Well, first things first. Let's consider how to live our lives in light of the Jesus' resurrection. In 1Corinthians 15:1-57 we read all about Jesus' resurrection by way of Paul's Spirit-inspired pen. After writing those 57 verses all about the concept of resurrection, we then come to the last verse in that lengthy chapter. Verse 58 says, "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your toil is not (in) vain in the Lord" (NASB).

Now *that* is how-to live-in light of the resurrection of Jesus Christ! Please take some time to think about that verse, and to pray over it. What might it look like if you were to be more *steadfast* at your job? What might it look like if you were to be more *immovable* in terms of your biblical beliefs when they clash with our culture? What might it look like if you were to be "always abounding in the work of the Lord"? Some who read this are already steadfast, already immovable, and already abounding. Others need to get there. And when you do, it will not have been in vain. Keep in mind that those three things in verse 58 are *commanded* by the Lord, not just suggested. They are not just good advice and self-help pop psychology. Keep the Faith! Focusing on the Glorious Risen Christ,
