Dear Church Family,

On October 23 I began a new sermon series. We looked together at Revelation 1:1-3. My plan is to preach fully through the first three chapters of this amazing book that comes as the last book in the Bible. We had just a small group present, so I will review some of the more important points. Whenever you have to miss a service, you can request the sermon manuscript (color-coded!) and the outline. I can mail or email it to you. We record the sermons via Facebook Live. It is saved/archived on my personal Facebook, so just send me a friend request if you want to have the video of that sermon.

What follows is some of the content of that sermon. The Book of Revelation begins with the words, "The revelation of Jesus Christ..." (1:1a). We learned that Jesus is the <u>possessor</u> of the Book of Revelation—it belongs to him! Jesus is the <u>source</u> of the Book of Revelation—it is *from* him! Jesus is the <u>content</u> of the Book of Revelation—it is *about* him!

We also learned about the name of Jesus. It is not just any name, so be careful how you say it. Never EVER use Jesus' name in a curse. How else might a person sin by misusing, or taking in vain, that holy, wonderful name? It is not only by using it as a curse word. It is also by making oaths using the Lord's name. Perhaps also by claiming to follow Jesus, but living a disgraceful life. Any of these words, any of these ways of using Jesus' name illegitimately, must be rejected.

Jesus' name is unique and amazing. That name above all names *is* amazing! And unique. Furthermore, we learned that the name of Jesus is loved by billions, yet hated by billions. So, "these are a few of my favorite things" about the sermon from Revelation 1 that I was privileged to preach.

But, one more thing. Since Thanksgiving is coming soon, I decided to see what the Book of Revelation has to say about the word "thanks." Some form of the word thanks occurs just three times in Revelation. In Revelation 4:9 we read, "...the living creatures give glory, honor and thanks to him who sits on the throne and who lives for ever and ever." And Revelation 7:11-12 says, "All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, <sup>12</sup> saying: 'Amen! Praise and glory and wisdom and thanks and honor and power and strength be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!" And then we have the final appearance of the word thanks. It occurs in Revelation 11:17, "We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign."

May you be stuffed with thanksgiving this Thanksgiving! Give thanks and Glory to God, the One and Only, the Only One worthy of our best giving of thanks!


