SHOW RULES:

This show is a pre-entry show only. All exhibitors must check in and verify their entries for accuracy. All Changes must be made prior to judging with the Show Secretary or Assistance. **NO COMMENT CARDS WILL BE USED.** Control sheets will be used at the judge's tables. We suggest that you use your check in sheets to record your placements.

We will refuse entries from exhibitors placing an entry from a location within **50 miles** from a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD within the past **30 days of the entry deadline.** Exhibitors, judges, registrars, transporters, and vendors residing in or traveling by motor vehicle through an area of the country that is part of an active RHD outbreak are discouraged from attending. **ARBA Guidelines will be followed.**

Portage County Rabbit & Cavy Club and its members are not responsible for loss in the event of fire, theft, or vandalism, nor is it responsible for exposure to COVID-19 or RHDV2. Attendees participate at their own risk.

All entries must be paid prior to judging, any entries not paid will result in all animals scratched for the show. **Those exhibitors who continue to enter shows and continue to be a no show will be responsible for payment of the entry fees.** After the 3rd no show of any of the Portage County Rabbit & Cavy Breeds Association, you will be contacted for payment of your entries. We reserve the right to refuse your entries if no payment is made for those entries.

No sales of any rabbits or cavies will be allowed by anyone not showing rabbits or cavy.

Youth rabbits must be placed on and removed from the table by a youth (between ages 5 and 18). It is assumed that a youth owns the animal and the animal is not owned by an adult. Due to safety concerns parents may assist youth with 6-class animals; however, the youth must be present at the table. Youth may not enter their rabbit in both open and youth classes at the same show, which is sponsored by the same club. Youth may make entries in both open and youth classes only with different animals in each show.

The show is governed by the latest ARBA Standards of Perfection and Show Rules and filing an entry indicates acceptance of our show rules. The show officials reserve the right to add or substitute judges as deemed necessary.

Judging will begin as close to the listed start times as possible. There may be a need to delay the start of the show due to traffic, construction or unforeseen delays.

Animals must be shown in the breed class to be shown in the fur class they cannot be shown if they were disqualified in the breed class.

Rabbits must be placed on the show table promptly after the breed has been called to the table. **DO NOT WAIT FOR YOUR NAME TO BE CALLED. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to monitor the show tables for their breed and class.** A class will be called 3 times then it will be closed. Any rabbits not placed on the show table will be considered a "SCRATCH" and no refund will be given.

INTERFERING WITH, ANNOYING, MOLESTING, OR INFLUENCING THE JUDGES AND/OR ACTING IN A MANNER UNBECOMING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN EJECTION FROM THE SHOWROOM

Diseased stock will be required to leave the showroom and entry fee forfeited.

No crock pots or hot plates are permitted in the building. National Club luncheons have had prior approval and are permitted.

No dogs, with the exceptions of special assistance dogs, will be permitted in the showroom, unless crated with prior permission.

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a fee of \$60.00, no checks will be permitted at future shows from the offender. If entry fee and returned check fee is not paid, then entry to future Portage County RCBA shows will not be permitted until all monies are collected.

All carriers must have bottoms to be in the showroom. No

ribbons are given at this show.

NO CLUB will hold a meeting during the Hall of Fame show that will result in suspending the judging of the show in any way.
