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All auction animals:

- Must be entered in the show.
- Will have a complete pedigree (even if the pedigree is not all JW). Having Fuzzy ND in the pedigree is acceptable, but it must include the ear number, sex, and color, and it should be identified as ND on the pedigree.
- Minimum age of 6 months at the time of auction.
- Pedigree is supplied to the solicitor when the donation is decided.
- Seniors registered/granded -- desired not required.
- Should include the following information for a Senior: Has it been proven? If a doe, has she been successful in raising a litter? If a buck, has he been successful in procreating/producing?
- The seller fills out a form regarding the rabbit's details – including age, sex, weight, sire and dam, ear length, leg length, registration status, grandparentage, and whether it has been proven. This sales information form will include the seller's name, rabbitry name, address, & phone number, to be turned in together with an email copy of the pedigree
- Solicitor will review pedigrees for basic information (tattoo#, DOB, weights, sex, color, and any ND notations). Any animals without a pedigree at auction time will not be sold. The sales information form will be provided to the solicitor to show the required information.
