

# Cookie Policy

We make use of cookies on our Website! A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer or other mobile devices when you access a website. Cookies help improve your user experience by recognising you when you revisit the website. Cookies we use on our website do not collect any personal data from your hard drive or computer.

There are different types of cookies. We are authorised to use cookies without your permission provided such cookies are strictly necessary for the operation of our website. However, if we use cookies that are not strictly necessary for the operation of our website we can only use them with your consent. You may withdraw your consent at any time.

## 1. Types of cookies on our website

We currently use three main types of cookies on our website: strictly necessary cookies, statistics cookies, and marketing cookies. Some of these cookies come from our website, and some come from third-party services that we use.

IDE	Marketing	Used by Google DoubleClick to register and report the website user's actions after viewing or clicking one of the advertiser's ads with the purpose of measuring the efficacy of an ad and to present targeted ads to the user.	HTTP	1 year
test_cookie	Marketing	Used to check if the user's browser supports cookies.	HTTP	1 day
VISITOR_INFO_LIVE	Marketing	Tries to estimate the users' bandwidth on pages with integrated Youtube videos.	HTTP	179 days
