- 1 Tbsp. Whole Cloves
- 2 Cinnamon Sticks
- 4 Cups Water
- 3 Small Tea Bags
- 4 Cups Boing Water
- Juice of four Oranges (two cups)
- Juice of One Lemon (1/4 cup)
