The Capitol was designed in 1785 by Thomas Jefferson. The General Assembly occupied the Capitol in 1788. The Virginia legislature voted to move the capital from Williamsburg to Richmond. Until a permanent capitol structure could be built, the Virginia General Assembly met in two wood-framed buildings at the corner of what is now 14th Street and Cary Street. These buildings were demolished before 1811, and a plaque now marks the site of these buildings. The Virginia State Capitol is a National Historic Landmark.
