So much of photography is paying attention, and then guessing what the right thing to do is going to be. The photo above was shot at the Area 27 race track in BC. I was definitely not there to get a fantastic landscape shot, but after a rain shower passed I was walking out to the marshall tower you see in the distance and I realized there was a picture but I wasn't sure what it was and how much should be in it and how much I should crop out. I stopped for a few minutes, took several shots with a telephoto lens to compress the distances, and got back to working with race cars. When I saw this shot on my computer screen it really hit me as a perfect feel for the track not just on that wet day, in fact I think it might be the best "environs" shot I've done around that track. It captures, for me, the feel of what is around that valley that makes it so interesting.


