## Correspondence:

Meeting: Water Loss Report was reviewed for September.

Council reviewed communications from the attorney regarding code enforcement at 8132 Lyman Avenue. Jeremy moved to have the attorney prepare a Notice of Violation, seconded by Mike Swanson; the motion carried unanimously. The clerk will contact the attorney to draft the NOV letter and request an estimate for further services.

Ordinance 305 was adopted amending chapter 9.10.067 of the Lyman Municipal Code to amend the non-resident endorsement threshold from \$2,000 to \$4,000 beginning January 1, 2026. Mike Couch made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Ron Hodgin seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Jim from Skagit County Fire District 8 was present to inform the town that they would like to extend their contract to rent the fire hall in Lyman for another year. Contract was given to council. Contract will be voted on at next council meeting.

CITIZENS & COUNCIL COMMENTS: Steve Sorby was present and asked about getting the speed limit lowered on Highway 20 going through Lyman. The mayor informed him he has made multiple attempts to get it lowered but was unsuccessful. Mayor said he would try again.
