The opening of the Rusk County Farmers Market's summer season will be on June 8th. This will be the first event held at the City of Ladysmith's new pavilion on the corner of Highway 8 and Second Street, across from the Rusk County Government Center. The farmers market will be at the pavilion on Saturdays from 8:30 am until noon and on Wednesdays noon until 4:00 pm.

The new pavilion is not the only new thing this season at the farmers market in Ladysmith. In partnership with OakLeaf Clinic Ladysmith, the market will be piloting a Prescription Produce Program, popular at farmers markets across the country. OakLeaf Providers will issue FoodRx vouchers to select patients. The farmers market will serve as the Farmacy for these prescriptions for fresh food.

The farmers market is also partnering with the City of Ladysmith, Toad House, and the Rusk Area Arts Alliance to expand the kid's area and activities at the market. Each market will feature an art, nature, gardening, or cooking project for kids and young-at-heart grown-ups.

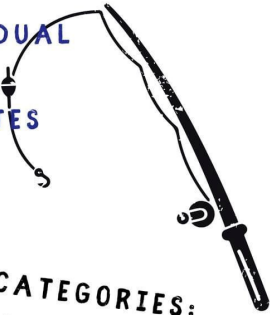

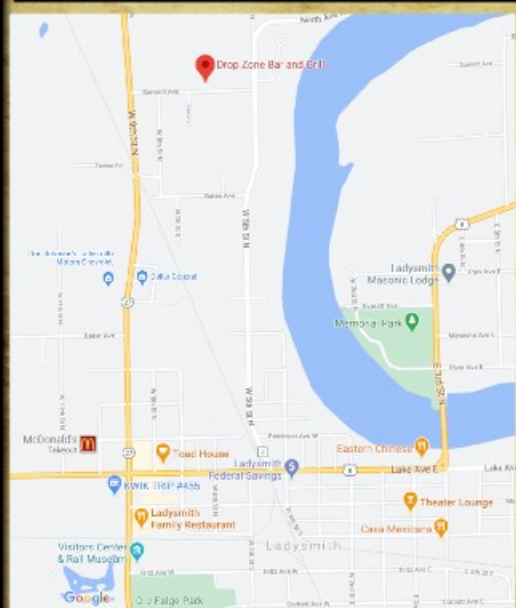

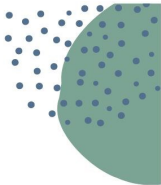

A CLEANSWEEP IS A SPECIAL SCHEDULED COLLECTION OF UNWANTED, UNUSED, DAMAGED, RESTRICTED OR BANNED HOUSEHOLD AND AGRICULTURAL WASTES.

Tuesday, June 25

2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Rusk Co. Highway Shop
(Across from OJ Falge Park, Ladysmith)

NO CHARGE:

- Households – no limit of hazardous material
- Farmers – up to 200 pounds of agricultural hazardous waste

REASONABLE FEE: Pre-registration required *

- Businesses
- Farmers – quantity greater than 200 pounds

*Pre-registration required – contact Zach Davis at zach.davis@veolia.com at least 2 weeks in advance



Acceptable Items Include: oil-based paints, solvents, pesticides, hazardous cleaners, corrosives, flammables, mercury, lead tackle and shot, old gas, antifreeze, and other chemicals you wouldn't consider dumping.

Not Acceptable: Latex Paint, Empty Paint Cans, Oil Filters, Motor Oil, Explosives, Flares or Fireworks, Freon 11 & 12, Radioactive Materials (including smoke/Co2 alarms), Ammunition, Compressed Gas Cylinders – any size, Recyclables, Asbestos, Biological or Infectious Wastes, Spray Foam Cylinders, Incandescent Light Bulbs, Alkaline Batteries

Cleansweep is an annual event. If you can't attend our event, please call 715-635-2197 or visit www.nwrpc.com for other surrounding area Cleansweep events. They can also tell you if an item is hazardous or not.

Tire Recycling Fees

\$3.00	Tires 12 inches & under
\$4.00	Tires 13 inches to 15 inches
\$7.00	Tires 16 to 19 inches
\$300/ton	Tires 20" and greater



Those that bring tires w/rims, large quantities, or tires 20" and greater will have to be weighed and pay price per ton which is equivalent to \$.15 per pound.
