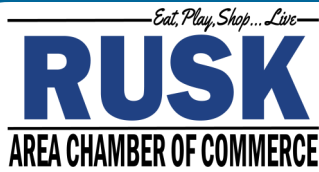
Hope Lutheran Church Cookie Walk (A part of Rusk County Winter Magic)

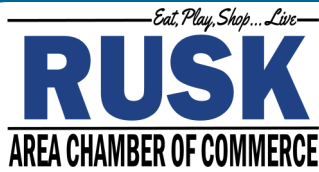
