- Tickets are **1 ticket for \$5 or 5 tickets for \$20.**
- Tickets can also be purchased at dismissal time on Tuesday 11/16, Wednesday 11/17 and Thursday 11/18 .
- Tickets must be returned to school no later than **Friday morning, November 19.**
