LET someone in charge know if I leave a netball venue	
RESPECT my team manager, coach and officials decisions	
UNDERSTAND that everyone has different strengths and recognise we play better	
as a team	
LOVE the game!!	
ENSURE I wear suitable kit for training and matches with my hair tied back, short	
nails and no jewellery	
SHOW great sportsmanship and teamwork, whether I win or lose and always thank	
everyone involved – the game would not go ahead without them
