ABOUT BLACK BOX BLACKOUT







Nearly 1000 people have attended Black Box events since it's first season in 2022.






Over 100 artists of color have participated in Blackbox events since 2022. This includes musicians, comedians, actors, chefs, poets and painters.

Blackbox is gearing up for an exciting new season with the launch of a Youtube channel and the release of several new films and series.


Expanding Our Reach:
