## Lake Maintenance Service Report

The water levels remain at normal full levels after the lake was refilled in November (2023) and no rainfall over the course of the week.

All four of the fountains are operational; 103<sup>rd</sup> Av, Bayside, Cameo and the Rec Center and all fountains running this week. Waterfall pump was operational and there is water movement in the lagoon and down the streams into the main lake.

No bottom algae seen and still limited planktonic algae growth in the water column but a slight increase in algae in the water column and decrease in clarity as there is some algae growth with the warmer weather.

The last couple of weeks have been unseasonably warm in the afternoon and only cool evening temperatures and the water temperatures are already trending up. Normally the lake starts to warm up in the early spring (March) but with a nonexistent winter and already spring temperatures the lake is warming early.

The 4 street grates adjacent to the lake are treated with dry larvicide dunks once a month year-round.

The warm winter, and now too early spring temperatures mean ideal conditions for midge flies especially if there is there is rain next week like it is forecast.

When the water temps reach mid 60s I will resume the larvicide treatments in the lagoon area. The lake itself is well stocked with goldfish to consume larvae in the main lake.

Normal trash removal and debris was skimmed off the surface and just the usual trash with no appreciable wind the past several weeks.

No appreciable wind action last week and a continued increase in temperatures so dissolved oxygen levels are lower. There is rainfall and cooler temperatures forecast for next week so temperatures may drop a slight amount.

No waterfowl mortality seen. 6 dead fish this week; 4 bass and 2 white amurs. No indications of golden algae or disease.

The trout seem to have acclimated well and mortality seen again this week.

The order for the goldfish and the blue gill is in, I am waiting to hear back on the delivery date. The fish will be split between the main lake and the lagoon area.

Periodic treatments are done twice a month with algaecide on the boat ramp have been suspended in the cooler weather and there is no new algae growth. With the warm up I will start the treatments back up as needed based on conditions.
