

Viewpoint Lake Use Rules

Who can use or fish at Viewpoint Lake:

Viewpoint Lake and RCSC boats are available to Cardholders and their invited guests, ages 6 years and older.

Cardholders and guests must check in at the Facility Attendant Station.

Guests under the age of 19 must be in the presence of the Cardholder.

Guests not accompanied by a Cardholder must obtain and display a Guest Day Pass and provide ID.

Use of the lake and RCSC boats are at the user's own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.

Prohibited Activities Include:

- Swimming, Wading, Snorkeling, Scuba Diving
- Depositing trash in or around the lake. Property owners will be charged if cleanup services are required.
- Feeding waterfowl or fish.
- Disturbing or harassing waterfowl.

Boating:

Arizona Boating Laws and Regulations apply. Each occupant is to have a USCG life preserver on board. Minimum age for children in RCSC boats is 6 years, and all children ages 12 and younger are required to wear their life preservers (available at Facilities Attendant Station) with all snaps snapped and zippers and fasteners closed while on the lake.

In an effort to prevent Golden Algae and Quagga Mussels in the lake, incoming watercraft, motor, trailer, fishing equipment and oars are to be clean and disinfected with a solution of 1 part bleach to 10 parts water prior to placing in Viewpoint Lake. Boats and trailers being transferred from other lakes should be disinfected and allowed to dry a minimum of 72 hours before being placed on Viewpoint Lake.

Boats shall not exceed 16 ft in length, 10hp maximum.

Launch ramp gate shall be locked at all times. See Facility Attendant at Mini Golf or call 623-561-4676 for access.

Other Rules:

- Wakeless Speed Only
- Mushroom or ball anchors only.
- No docking against the lake’s edge.
- Model boat use allowed by Cardholders who assume responsibility for keeping model boats clear of watercraft or fishermen.
- *** Please see specific rules posted at the Facilities Attendant Station for use of RCSC rowboats and pedal-boats.*

Prohibited:

Jet Skis

Towables

Fishermen’s Float Tubes or Waders

Any other flotation device unless USCG approved and labeled.

Fishing:

Viewpoint Lake is private water – no state license is required.

One pole per person, with two hooks maximum or two poles with only one hook each. No unattended poles/lines (trotline) allowed.

Hours: Dawn to Dusk

Fishing from shore: fishing is allowed in common areas, except areas designated “No Fishing” and the RCSC boat dock area.

Fishing from boat: fish no closer than 25 feet from shoreline, the screen outlet near Cameo Bridge, any dock or any other boat.

Hooks caught on boats, property or other objects shall not be jerked or pulled. Please cut the line and tie to the object hooked. Inform owner if property damage involved.

Daily Fish Limit Allowed:

Largemouth Bass 1 bass, 13 inch minimum length

Catfish / Trout 3 fish (any combination)

Bluegill / Sunfish / Common Carp 5 fish (any combination)

White Amur (grass carp)..... Catch & Release Only
