Disco Spin Earrings & Necklace



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Materials:

Earrings

- 2 Centerline Medalions
- 2 Earwires
- 20 6mm Bugles (10 each of 2 colors if desired)
- 2 yards 6lb Fireline

Necklace:

- 1 Centerline Medalions
- 16 6mm Bugles (9 of 1st color, 7 of 2nd color if desired)
- 2 yards 6lb Fireline
- 1 Oval Jump Ring
- 21/2 feet Oval Rolo Chain

Tools:

- 1 Bead Mat
- 1 Chain Nose Pliers
- 1 Wire Cutters
- 1 Scissors
- 1 Needle (10/0 or 12/0)



Centerline Medalion with Bugles:

Step 1

A. Cut 1 yard of Fireline. Thread a needle onto one end.

String **One Bugle** and let it slide down the Fireline. leaving about a 4 inch tail. Lay Bugle into a slot of

Centerline Medalion.

Bring needle down through the outside hole next to the slot.

B. Flip Centerline Medalion so backside is facing you. Bring needle through the Bugle.





C. Bring needle through the inside hole next to the slot. Flip Centerline Medalion so Front side is facing you. Tail and working thread should be on same side.



Step 2

Tie tail and working thread together with a square knot. Bring tails (one at a time) into the Bugle to pull and hide the knot into the Bugle. Trim both threads.



Step 3 Repeat Steps 1 & 2 to add another Bugle into the next slot. (Choose a Second Color for the Bugle if desired).





Step 4

Continue adding Bugles into each slot, alternating Colors if desired.



For Earrings

A. Open the loop of the **Earwire** and attach to the Centerline Medalion.



B. Make the **Second Earring** by following Steps 1- 4 to make a Centerline Medalion with Bugles then attach an Earwire.



For Necklace

A. Follow Steps 1-4 to make a Centerline Medalion with Bugles.



B. Cut Five pieces of Chain, each 15 links long.



C. Add a Needle to one end of about 1 Yard of Fireline. String
One Bugle. Bring needle through the end link of a piece of Chain, then back through the Bugle. Leave about a 3-4 inches tail.

D. Bring needle through the end link of a **new piece of Chain**, then back through the Bugle.

E. Bring needle through the link of the first Chain, the Bugle, then through the link of the Second Chain.

The working thread and tail thread should be on the same side of chain.



F. Tie working thread and tail together in a square knot.

Bring working thread and tail (one at a time) through the Bugle so the knot is hidden in the Bugle.


Trim ends.



 $G_{\:\raisebox{1pt}{\text{\circle*{1.5}}}}$ Add another \bf Bugle and \bf piece of \bf Chain by following C - F of the Necklace section.



H. Add **2 Bugles** and **2 Chains** following C - F of Necklace section. Use a Second Color if desired, adding one to each side.



I. Use the same method in C - F to attach a **Bugle** and the long leftover **Chain**. Use the first Color of Bugle.



J. Check length of necklace, Cut Chain if needed.

Use same method to attach the two ends of the Chains together with the same color Bugle as Color 1.



K. Use the **Oval Jump Ring** to attach the Centerline Medalion to the center link of the middle 15 link Chain.
