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# Fancy, Fun and Bold Necklace

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Instructions by Joyce Trowbridge

## Materials:

- 9 14mm Melon Czech Beads (**Melon**)
- 23-25 8mm Fire Polish Czech Beads (**FP8**)
- 34-40 6mm Fire Polish Czech Beads (**FP6**)
- 18 TierraCast 6mm Beaded Spacer Beads (**Spacer**)
- 15 Inches Flat Oval Cable Chain 9x5mm
- 2 TierraCast Beaded 3-1 Links
- 1 TierraCast Bar & Ring Clasp
- 4 TierraCast Medium Oval Jump Rings
- 45 Inches Soft Flex Medium Beading Wire
- 6 2mm Crimp Tubes
- 6 4mm Crimp Covers

## Tools:

- 1 Bead Mat
- 2 Chain Nose Pliers
- 3 Bead Stoppers
- 1 Crimper
- 1 Wire Cutters
- 1 Flexible Beading Wire Cutter



## Step 1

Cut **15 Inches of Beading Wire**. Place a **Bead Stopper** a couple inches from one end.



## Step 2

String **1 FP6, 1 Spacer, 1 Melon, 1 Spacer**.



## Step 3

Continue stringing the bead pattern from Step 2 for a total of **9 sets**.



## Step 4

String **1 FP6**. Add a second **Bead Stopper** to this side.



## Step 5

Cut a new piece of **Beading Wire 15 inches long**. Add to one of the **Bead Stoppers** above the beaded strand.





**Step 6**

String **23-25 FP8** beads. Just enough to nestle above the other beaded strand. Attach the loose end to the other Bead Stopper with the other beaded strand end.

**Step 7**

Cut a new piece of **Beading Wire 15 inches** long. Add to one of the Bead Stoppers above the other two beaded strands.

**Step 8**

String **26-30 FP6** beads. Just enough to nestle above the other beaded strands. Attach the loose end to the other Bead Stopper with the other beaded strand ends.

**Step 9**

Remove the Melon and FP6 strand from the set. Add a **Bead Stopper** to one end.

**Step 10**

String **1 Crimp**, go through the *bottom* loop of the **3-1 Link**, then back through the Crimp. Use a Crimping Plier to secure the Crimp. Attach a **Crimp Cover** over the crimped crimp with Chain Nose Pliers.

**Step 11**

Repeat Step 10 for other side of this beaded strand.





**Step 12**

Remove the FP8 strand from the set. Attach a **Bead Stopper** to one end.

**Step 13**

String **1 Crimp**, go through the *middle loop* of the 3-1 Link, then back through the Crimp. Use a Crimping Plier to secure the Crimp. Attach a **Crimp Cover** over the crimped crimp with Chain Nose Pliers.

**Step 14**

On the other side, string **1 Crimp** and go through *middle loop* of the 3-1 link. Check this strand for length. Add or subtract beads if needed.

**Step 15**

Go back through the Crimp. Use a Crimping Pliers to secure the Crimp. Attach a **Crimp Cover** over the crimped crimp with Chain Nose Pliers.

**Step 16**

Remove Bead Stopper from one end of the FP6 Beaded Strand. String **1 Crimp**, go through the *top loop* of the 3-1 Link, then go back through the Crimp. Use a Crimping Plier to secure the crimp. Attach a **Crimp Cover**

**Step 17**

Remove the Bead Stopper from the other side. String **1 Crimp**. Go through the *top loop* of the 3-1 Link. Check length of this beaded strand with the others. Adjust if needed by adding or subtracting beads.





## Step 18

Go back through the Crimp. Use Crimping Pliers to secure the Crimp. Attach a **Crimp Cover** over the Crimped Crimp with Chain Nose Pliers.



## Step 19

Cut **2 pieces of Chain**, each 5-7½ inches long. *Note: If not sure about length, start with the longer and adjust in the next step.*

Attach each Chain piece to the single loop of the 3-1 Link with an **Oval Jump Ring** using Chain Nose Pliers.



## Step 20

Adjust chain if needed for desired length.

Attach each part of the **Clasp** to the chain with an **Oval Jump Ring** using Chain Nose Pliers.
