

Herringbone Necklace



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Instructions by Joyce Trowbridge

Materials:

- 12 8x6mm Rondelle Czech Glass Beads
- 14 5x6mm Bell Flower Czech Glass Beads
- 13 feet 22 gauge Wire
- 3 feet Flat Oval Cable Chain
- 20 Medium Oval Jump Rings

Tools:

- Bead Mat
- 2 Chain Nose Pliers
- Round Nose Pliers
- Wire Cutters
- Ruler



Step 1

Cut **18 inches of 22 gauge Wire**. Make a wrapped loop with 7 coils. Trim the tail after last coil.



Step 2

String **1 Bell Flower, 1 Rondelle and 1 Bell Flower**. Make a Wrapped Loop with 7 coils after the last Bell Flower added. *Don't cut wire.*



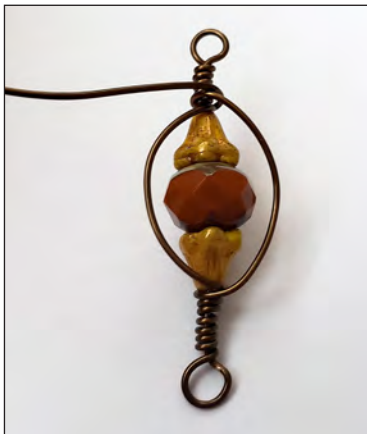
Step 3

Bring wire along the side of the beads. Wrap the wire around the coils on the other side of the beads, from the front, around to the back, then to the front.



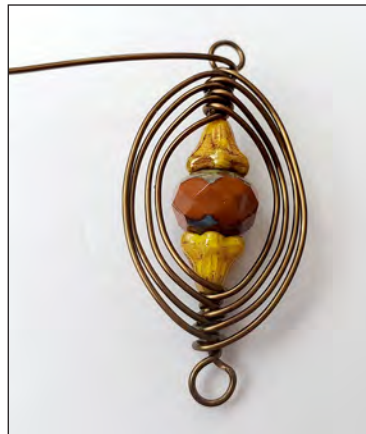
Step 4

Bring the wire up along the side of the beads. Wrap wire around the coil, above the last wrap.



Step 5

Repeat Steps 3 & 4 until you have four wires on either side of the beads.



Step 6

Cut the wire tail after the last wrap.



Step 7

Follow Steps 1-6 to make more Herringbone Links. Herringbone Links may come out looking different. The more you make, the more they blend together in the finished necklace.



Step 8

Make some **Bead Links** with the extra beads.



Step 9

Place Herringbone Links and Bead Links in a pattern.



Step 10

Cut pieces of the **Chain** to put between the Links to space them out, if desired. Use **Oval Jump Rings** to connect the Links and Chains together to finish your necklace.
