

Lampwork Candy Necklace

Materials:

- 5 Disc Lampwork Glass Beads
- 6 TierraCast Large Hole Bead, 7mm Beaded Bead
- 1 TierraCast Button
- 1 TierraCast Distressed 4x2mm Barrel Bead
- 5 feet 1 mm Leather Cord

Tools:

- Bead Mat
- Chain Nose Pliers
- Cutters



Step 1

Bring both ends of the **Leather Cord** together to find the center. Tie a knot, leaving a loop for the button to fit in.



Step 2

String the **Large Hole Bead** onto both ends of the Leather Cord together. Leave about a 7 inch space between the knot and the Large Hole Bead. *If the Large Hole Bead slides too much, tie an Overhand Knot at the 7 inch spot.*



Step 3

Separate the ends of the Leather Cord. Cross them through a **Lampwork Bead**. Bring up against the Large Hole Bead.



Step 4

Bring both ends together. String on a **Large Hole Bead**. Bring up against the Lampwork Bead.



Step 5

Repeat Steps 3 and 4 for the remainder **Lampwork Beads** and **Large Hole Beads**. Tie an **Overhand Knot** after the last **Large Hole Bead**, if desired.



Step 6

Bring both ends together. String on the **Barrel Bead**. String up through *one* hole of the **Button**, then back down through the *second* hole of the **Button** and the **Barrel Bead**. Adjust to leave about 7 inches between the **Large Hole Bead** and **Barrel Bead**.



Step 7

Use **Chain Nose Pliers** to squeeze the **Barrel Bead** flat so the **Leather Cord** doesn't move. Trim ends.
