

Privacy Policy for Maternal Matters Favored

Maternal Matters Favored ("we", "our", or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and protect your personal information when you interact with our website, participate in our programs, or engage with our services.

By using our website or participating in any of our activities, you consent to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

- **Legal Requirements**: We may disclose your information when required to do so by law, such as to comply with a subpoena or other legal process, or to protect the rights, property, and safety of Maternal Matters Favored, our participants, or others.
