Defines and interprets strategic requirements, analyzes and provides guidance on strategic issues. Develops and leads projects including defining scope, objectives, and methods. Applies and/or develops advanced technologies, scientific principles, theories, and concepts. Often serves as a subject matter expert for specialized consulting assignments. Individual is recognized as a thought leader and an expert in the field, providing a major impact on customer success and productivity.

Management Services: Individual has management oversight of all major functions, disciplines, or segments of a program/project relating to services such as consulting, facilitation, training, and program/project management disciplines. Responsibilities may include long range planning, and full responsibility for all aspects of program/project performance.

Support Services: Duties may include activities related to program administration, scheduling, contracts, and pricing. Individual contributes to the development of new concepts, techniques, and standards supporting

services such as consulting, facilitation, training, and program/project management disciplines. Creates and identifies solutions to complex problems. Ensures solutions are consistent with program objectives. Individual acts as an advisor to customers and is considered an expert in the field within the program.

Support Services: Duties may include activities related to program administration, scheduling, contracts and pricing. Complete understanding and application of principles, concepts, practices, and standards supporting services such as consulting, facilitation, training, and program/project management disciplines. Full knowledge of industry practices. Demonstrates the skill to perform fairly complex professional tasks and develop solutions.

Job requires frequent use and general knowledge of industry practices, techniques, standards and a general application of concepts and principles to support services such as consulting, facilitation, training, and program/project management disciplines. Demonstrates the skill and ability to perform moderately complex professional tasks, and develop solutions to a variety of problems of moderate scope and complexity.

Functional Responsibilities:
