





#### Convention 2025 High Speed at Road America update!

During the May Governors Meeting Weekend, the Competition Committee voted 13-2-1 on a Clarification during their May 2, 2025 meeting to allow all C-8 Corvette Convertibles to run in Group 1, Group 1S and Group 2 in sanctioned NCCC High Speed Events as long as the top is securely attached as designed. All other corvette convertibles must still meet all of the NCCC Rulebook requirements for convertibles to have a roll bar to run high speed events.

#### Therefore

C-8 Convertibles will be allowed to run the High Speed event at Convention 2025 being held at Road America on their 4.1 mile track on 08-18-2025.

#### PLEASE make note of the following:

- All NCCC Members wishing to enter any Sanctioned Event Competition at convention must first be registered for all of Convention Week.
- 2. No one will be permitted to compete in a Sanctioned Event on a Day Pass.
- No Passengers will be allowed during any Low Speed Autocross or High Speed runs at Road America on August 19, 2025.
- All registrations for Sanctioned Competition Events must be made by July 15, 2025.
   Class Entry changes will not be allowed after July 15, 2025 without a written email request to the <u>Convention Treasurer</u> and permission has been granted.


