President's Message

May 2023

Here we are into May and events are gearing up! Hope you are all getting out to enjoy your Corvette!

FIRST – There has been a lot of conversation about what NCCC has decided about the upcoming E Ray Corvette. I would like to clarify the discussion at the November meeting compared to what has appeared across the media: Discussion concerned the electric cars (plug in kind) that have caught fire. We did not include hybrid cars in that discussion. Hybrids are allowed at our competitions and E-Rays will be welcomed at our events.

Speaking with fellow National Corvette Museum board member and Corvette product marketing manager Harlan Charles at the Bash, he shared that E-Ray has been tested extensively in rigorous track environments. During development, the team completed more than 1,500 track laps, including continuous lapping, plus robust durability testing. E-Ray complies with NHTSA crash test standards and was built to meet with recommendations by Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) and International Organization for Standardization (ISO) regarding emergency responder access to critical hardware.

E-Ray's battery is also packaged directly in the middle of the vehicle, surrounded by structural metal, so it is safe from impact. Lastly, E-Ray's battery pack self-monitors for signs of hazard and disengage from the propulsion system if needed.

I can't wait to see E-Rays competing at our events!

Just got back from the Bash at the National Corvette Museum. Whew what an event. We lucked out on the weather- sort of - since it did not rain buckets. Thanks to Craig Kamradt and Steve Johnson for manning our booth! Dale and Carolyn Samuelson as well as Denny were backup! We even got a few prospects for new clubs and members.

The new Education Center is awesome. It is set up to allow you to design your own car on computers. They are also set up to have schools come and spend the day to learn about the Corvette and have some fun too.

The 70th Anniversary and E-Ray cars were on display too. GM even brought a cut-away version so everyone could see the technology. Lots of Museum deliveries were going on so we got to see lots of different color combinations.

Hope you are geared up for convention. It's going to be a big one! What a great time to reconnect with friends from all over the US. 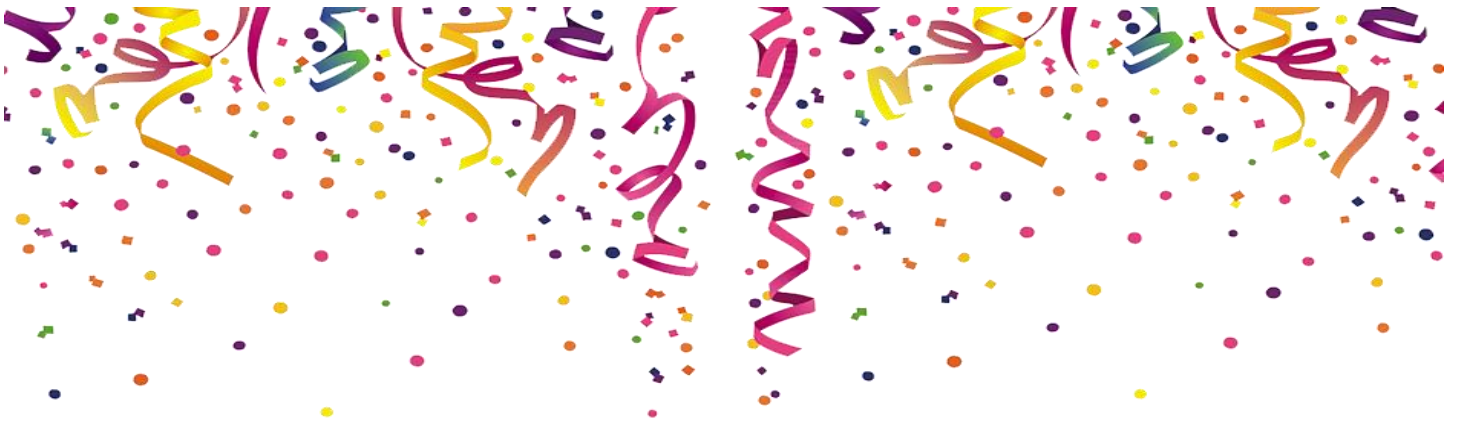

A candidate must be an Active member (see Section 3, Article II above).2. Deleted July 20063. And not hold office concurrently with any other N.C.C.C. sanctioned club.
